The process to become an accredited volunteer driver for a Community Passenger Network in SA is controlled by the Department of Planning, Transport & Infrastructure (DPTI) and has no cost for you.

On completion of the accreditation process, an Accredited Volunteer Driver permit will be issued by DPTI and is valid for 6 years.

MMCPN will support you with the application process.
